

Churchill Place

Churchill Place is situated in the attractive South Norfolk Village of Brooke which is surrounded by a wooded area set around two reedy meres (lakes). St Peter's, the local church is 800 years old and is one of 124 existing round-tower churches in Norfolk. The village sits approx. seven miles south of the City of Norwich and is also approx. seven miles from the Suffolk town of Bungay

Churchill Place scheme consists of 37 one and two bedroomed bungalows, a one bedroomed flat and three two bedroomed flats, all of which are managed by a team of (non- resident) Housing Support Coordinators.

Each property is fitted with a communication system, which allows two-way speech between the Support Coordinator's office and the tenants' homes.

Pull cords are fitted in every room in the properties, which tenants can use in case of an emergency. Residents are also given an individual pendant. When the Scheme Coordinator is off duty, any emergency calls will be answered by the call centre which is operated 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Our facilities include a large communal lounge which is furnished and available to all residents for social and recreational activities. Adjoining the lounge is a fully equipped kitchen available for residents to make light refreshments. There are also laundry facilities available and are free for tenants living on the scheme to use.
