

Depwade Court

Depwade Court is situated in the South Norfolk village of Long Stratton which is approx. 12 miles from the City of Norwich and a similar distance from the lovely market town of Diss. There is a doctors, dentists, pubs, cafes, a Post Office, library and a range of shops; which are located along the main street and in two small shopping centres called South Norfolk Shopping Precinct and The Icehouse Precinct – which is known as this because it was built near the remains of a Victorian icehouse, once belonging to Long Stratton Manor House before it was demolished after World War One.

Depwade Court is located in the centre of Long Stratton and consists of 25 one bedroom bungalows around a green, three two-bedroom bungalows which are in Welholmes Close and seven two bedroom bungalows in Snape Hall Road.

Depwade Court and is managed by a team of (non-resident) Housing Support Coordinators.

Each property is fitted with a communication system, which allows two-way speech between the Support Coordinators office and the tenants' homes. Pull cords are fitted in every room in the properties, which tenants can use in case of an emergency. Residents are also given an individual pendant. When the Scheme Coordinator is off duty, any emergency calls will be answered by the call centre which is operated 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Our facilities include a large communal lounge which is furnished and available to all residents for social and recreational activities. Adjoining the lounge is a fully equipped kitchen available for residents to make light refreshments. There are also laundry facilities available and are free for tenants living on the scheme to use.
