

Marion Roberts Court

Marion Roberts Court is approximately half a mile from the centre of the large village of Hethersett, which is situated between Norwich and Wymondham. The village has a pub, shops, a Post Office, medical centre, pharmacy, dentist and a library. Buses run to both Norwich and Wymondham half hourly during the day.

Marion Roberts Court consists of 35 one bedroom bungalows. The Scheme is managed by a team of (non-resident) Housing Support Coordinators.

Each property is fitted with a communication system, which allows two-way speech between the Support Coordinators office and the tenants' homes. Pull cords are fitted in every room in the properties, which tenants can use in case of an emergency. Residents are also given an individual pendant. When the Scheme Coordinator is off duty, any emergency calls will be answered by the call centre which is operated 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Our facilities include a large communal lounge which is furnished and available to all residents for social and recreational activities. Adjoining the lounge is a fully equipped kitchen available for residents to make light refreshments. There are also laundry facilities available and are free for tenants living on the scheme to use.
