

Millfields

Millfields is situated on the outskirts of the picturesque village of Hempnall, which is approximately four miles from Long Stratton and nine miles from Norwich. The village is one of a handful in South Norfolk which has two fords running through it and fortunately these are mostly dry.

Facilities in Hempnall include a Village Hall, doctors and a convenience store. 'The Hempnall Trust', a village charity, runs The Hempnall Mill Centre at the site of Hempnall Mill which offers a lunch club and monthly café.

Millfields Scheme consists of 15 one bedroom bungalows and is managed by a team of (non-resident) Housing Support Coordinators.

Each property is fitted with a communication system, which allows two-way speech between the Support Coordinators office and the tenants' homes. Pull cords are fitted in every room in the properties, which tenants can use in case of an emergency. Residents are also given an individual pendant. When the Scheme Coordinator is off duty, any emergency calls will be answered by the call centre which is operated 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Our facilities include a large communal lounge which is furnished and available to all residents for social and recreational activities. Adjoining the lounge is a fully equipped kitchen available for residents to make light refreshments. There are also laundry facilities available and are free for tenants living on the scheme to use.
