

Scudamore Place

Scudamore Place is situated in the village of Ditchingham which lies close to the Norfolk/Suffolk border by the River Waveney. Anglia Buses provide a service to both Norwich and the historical market town of Bungay. The bus stop is opposite the scheme. The local doctor's surgery is in Bungay. Bungay also has a wide variety of shops, a supermarket and tea rooms. There is also a market on the Buttercross every Thursday morning.

The Scudamore Place Scheme consists of 45 one and two bedroom bungalows. It is managed by a team of (non- resident) Housing Support Coordinators.

Each property is fitted with a communication system, which allows two-way speech between the Support Coordinators office and the tenants' homes. Pull cords are fitted in every room in the properties, which tenants can use in case of an emergency. Residents are also given an individual pendant. When the Scheme Coordinator is off duty, any emergency calls will be answered by the call centre which is operated 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Our facilities include a large communal lounge which is furnished and available to all residents for social and recreational activities. Adjoining the lounge is a fully equipped kitchen available for residents to make light refreshments. There are also laundry facilities available and are free for tenants living on the scheme to use.
